The document dated 10 March 1800 tells us James Whiteford was born in 1773 in St Stephen in Brannel, Cornwall. At the age of 7 he was apprenticed to Richard Colding of St Stephens. He served out his apprenticeship and was then drawn into the Cornish Militia. He served 5 years and was discharged from the militia on the 25th September, 1799. He immediately went to the Parish of Littleham where he took a house and was to give eleven pounds, five shillings a year in rent.

The document sworn on the 2nd January, 1809 tells us James was born in St Stephen in Brannel, Cornwall which was the place of his parents settlement. When he was about 8 years old he was bound by apprenticeship by the church wardens to Richard Cowlin of St Stephens in Brannel, where he served out his apprenticeship in full. Soon after he was drawn into the Cornish Militia and served 5 years. He then went to Littleham and then married and went to work as a day labourer for about 12 months and then took an Orchard of Mr Menie at the yearly rate of two pounds 12 shillings and six pence and he paid the land tax and poor rates for the said Orchard. He says he has not done any other act or deed by which to gain a settlement only as above. He previously rented a property in Littleham for 11 pounds a year but at this time he rents an Orchard.

Both documents bear the mark of James Whiteford which would suggest he was illiterate.

From Census records in 1841 we know John's wife was called Mary.

There is a marriage record for a Mary Rowe and James Whitford in Plymouth in 1799 and there is a marriage record for Mary Hooper and James Wightford at Littleham in 22 Oct 1799. The latter is probably the correct record, but it does not tally with the sworn statement as there is no mention of him being married in his first statement.

The family were non-conformists in later life. There appeared to be strong links between the Wesleyan communities at Littleham and Plymouth.

1841 Census indicates James was born in the county of Devon but based on other documents this would appear to be incorrect.

1841 Census lists Elizabeth aged 35, Mary aged 15 and Martha aged 5 as living with James and Mary Whiteford. Mary and Martha were James Whitford's grandchildren; children to his son William Henry.

James Whitford and his wife Mary died before the 1851 census so there is only limited information available.

There are two marriages at Littleham for a Mary Ann Whiteford and Harriet Whiteford - these were probably James and Mary's children. I have only been able to find a birth/baptism for their daughter Elizabeth. The others remain ellusive, including William Henry Whiteford.

Naval records state James was born in 1879 and was a blacksmith by trade before joining the Royal Navy. James was actually born in 1876.

Prior to WW1 James served aboard the HMS Algerine as a stoker - he saw action at the taking of the Taku Forts during the Boxer Rebellion in 1900 and was awarded the China Medal 1900 with a Taku Forts Clasp. From surviving accounts it would seem this was a fierce battle which began at night. The larger ships of the International fleet were not able to negotiate the bar at Taku and so smaller ships were deployed up the river to attack the forts. Of those ships the HMS Algerine was the largest. Some accounts say that the HMS Algerine fired the first shot. The ship was pounded on both sides and it sustained much damage. One story is that the Algerine bore the brunt of the attack and only survived because at the height of the barrage a flood light fell from one of the tower forts, which enabled her to change position.

James became a Stoker 1st Class and served on many ships in this capacity during WW1. It would seem he was probably injured during WW1. His service record shows he was transferred to HMS Vivid (naval base) a month before the Battle of Jutland in 1916, for a year (possibly overcoming an injury). I have found evidence that James was issued with a Silver War Badge (denoting injury), but it was returned.

James died in 1921 and is classified as WW1 Commonwealth War Dead, indicating he died due to the injuries he sustained during the war. His wife also received a war widow's pension. His naval record indicates he was invalided out in 1919 due to Influenza and Bronchitis; his injuries may have weakened him or he may have had a lung condition due to the nature of his working conditions.

He was awarded the China Medal 1900 (Taku Forts) and a "long service and good conduct" medal in 1919. A search of the Royal Navy medal rolls located at Kew have established James was entitled to receive the 1915 Star, the Victory Medal and the British War Medal, however these were never issued/claimed. All WW1 unclaimed medals have been destroyed. He was also entitled to a Silver War Badge.

James William Pope is not listed on the War Memorial at Exeter Highter Cemetery. He was buried at Exeter Higher Cemetery on the 6th July 1921, aged 44. His grave site is D37-37

He left a Will (as did most naval personnel) but it was not probated until 1924. Probate was granted to William John Yates, James William Pope's brother in law. Effects were valued at 162 Pounds 7 shillings and 4 pence.
